

Contract on Grant for Activities Supporting Physical Activity and Well-being for Children and Youth, and for the Development of the Ummeljoki Recreational Area

1. Parties

2. Background and Purpose of the Contract

As part of its corporate responsibility measures related to its data center investment in the Kouvola region, atNorth Oy has expressed its willingness to grant City of Kouvola a financial contribution totaling 18,000.00 Euros.

The purpose and aim of the grant is to promote equal opportunities for children and youth living in Kouvola to engage in physical activity and sports, to increase participation in sports regardless of their background, and to ensure equal access to sports activities while fostering community and physical well-being of children and youth.

The second purpose and aim of the grant is to support the development of the Ummeljoki recreational area, which is owned and managed by City of Kouvola.

With this contract, the Parties agree on the uses of the grant provided by atNorth Oy referred to herein and on the obligations of City of Kouvola, as the recipient of the grant, to report on the use of the grant to atNorth Oy as the grantor.

3. Grant Amount and Allocation

atNorth Oy grants City of Kouvola a total of 18,000.00 Euros for the 2025 operational period, to be used for the purposes described in Section 2.

Of this grant, a total amount of 10,000.00 Euros will be allocated to activities supporting physical activity and well-being for children and youth. The Parties have agreed that this amount shall be used for supporting swimming lessons for students at Myllykoski school in Kouvola.

Of this grant, 8000,00 Euros will be allocated to the development of the Ummeljoki recreational area which is owned and managed by City of

Kouvola. Development measures include the maintenance of trails, stormwater management, and the prevention of invasive plant species in the recreational area.

atNorth Oy will transfer the full grant amount to City of Kouvola's bank account FI32 5750 0120 1886 78 (OKOYFIHH) by October 31, 2025.

4. Monitoring the Use of the Grant

City of Kouvola commits to reporting annually to atNorth Oy on the use of the grant by the end of December. City of Kouvola shall report to atNorth Oy the following information regarding the use of the grants it has provided:

1. How the grant was used (allocation and actual expenses)
2. Participation rates and demographic data
3. Feedback from children and families
4. Evaluation of results and impact

5. Other Conditions Regarding the Use of the Grant

City of Kouvola, as the recipient of the grant, commits to using the grant for the purposes and allocations agreed upon in this contract. If a justified need arises to change the allocation after signing this contract, City of Kouvola must promptly notify atNorth Oy thereof.

6. Entry into Force and Signatures

This contract enters into force once signed by both Parties and approved by the competent authority, official, or representative of each Party. Any amendments to this contract must be made in writing and agreed upon by both Parties.
